**Kultur/ Grammatik**

German has three articles: der, die and das

der = masculine

die = feminine

das = neutral

also: use “die’ for all plurals, no matter what the article was

Comparative: The comparative in German takes an –er at the end of the adjective, just as it does in English with many words. If possible it also often takes an Umlaut.

schnell → schneller

laut → lauter

alt → älter

When using „no“ in front of nouns, we use „kein.“ do NOT use nein or nicht: “Ich habe kein Wasser.”
